Description:

- Collect information from relevant parties involved in the incident.
- Assist with incident investigations.
- Communicate and implement recommendations resulting from incident investigations.

Assessment:

Students will receive a Certificate of Attendance for completing the face to face course. Upon successful completion of the post course assignment within 3 months of the course, participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for BSBWHS406 Assist with responding to incidents.
